Pizza and a Movie

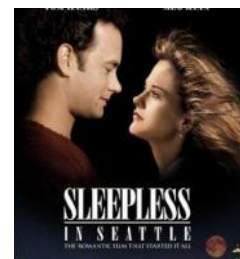
Pizza and a Movie night is **\$5.00 per person, to be paid at the front desk when you sign up.** And the winner of the number one favorite movie is...
