FIRST MAN is Academy Award-winning Damien Chazelle's biopic about Neil Armstrong (Ryan Gosling). It takes place between 1961 and 1969, the years that took Armstrong from being a test pilot in California to a pioneering NASA astronaut in Houston to the first person to walk on the moon. While he's still flying planes in the Mojave desert, Neil and his wife, Janet (Claire Foy), experience the loss of their second child, Karen, who dies from brain cancer. Neil is then hired to officially join NASA's space program in Houston.
